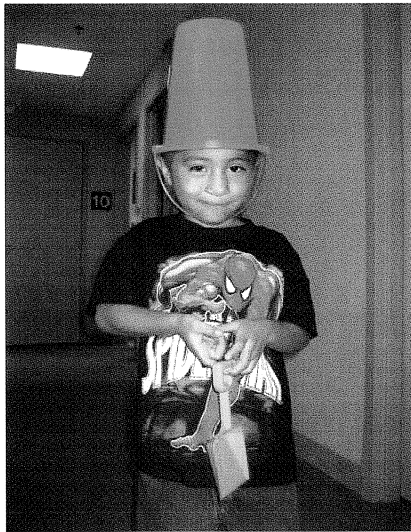


Cleft Lip/ Cleft Palate



Description: A clinic for children born with cleft lip, cleft palate or other craniofacial anomalies. The clinic is a member of the American Cleft Palate-Craniofacial Association which has established the highest level of care and management for children born with this birth defect in the United States.

Time: 1st Friday 8:00 a.m. of each month

Place: Sutherland Institute KUMC Hospital

Seating Clinic



Description: A clinic for children up to age 21 who have a disability and need to be fitted for a wheelchair. An assessment is done to determine other equipment or assistive technology they may need for home or school. Kansas Medicaid requires all children on their program to be seen in an approved seating clinic prior to payment for wheelchairs.

Team: Rehabilitation physician, occupational therapist, physical therapist, certified vendors, nurse practitioner and social worker.

Time: 2nd & 4th Thursday of each month at 1:00 pm

Place: KUMC at Child Health and Development 1st floor Clinic Area.

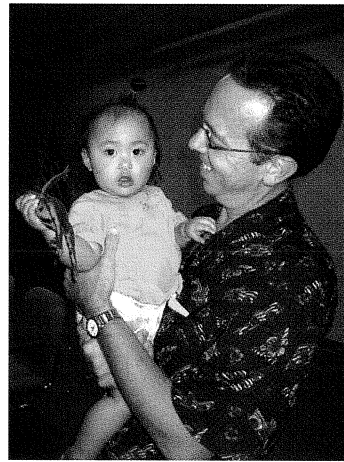

Cerebral Palsy Clinic



Description: Cerebral Palsy is a disability caused by an infection or brain damage in a child at birth or shortly thereafter. Children with CP may have stiff muscles or difficulty with movements. They can be mildly affected or experience significant limitations in functioning. This clinic provides a multi-disciplinary approach to their care.

Time: 2nd Monday afternoon of each month

Place: KUMC Center for Child Health and Development 1st floor clinic area.

Staff: physicians, nurse practitioner, physical therapists, social worker, dietitian.

Spina Bifida Clinic

Description: This clinic is designed for ages birth to 21 who have a diagnosis of spina bifida. Spina bifida affects the spinal cord and causes some problems with functioning and paralysis or lack of sensation in the area below the site where this spine is malformed. This is a genetic condition that occurs prior to birth.

Time: 1st Thursday afternoon of each month

Place: 2nd floor of KUMC Hospital

Staff: Neurosurgeon, orthopedist, urologist, rehabilitation medicine, physical therapist, occupational therapist, dietitian and social worker
